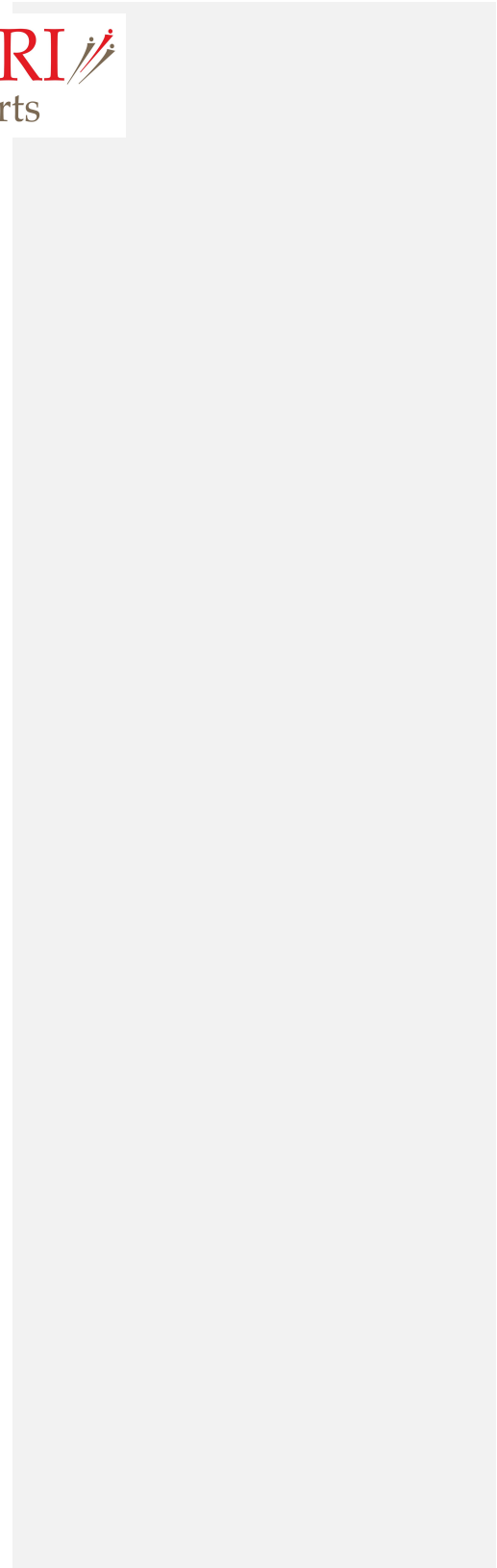

Overview: This document is to be used as a guideline to recommence business at the Townsville Dart Association Hall located at 37 Mervyn Crossman Drive, Annandale QLD 4818

TRAINING:

All committee members and volunteer staff have completed Covid-19 Training as per the below link.

All members/ Participants have been and/or will be encouraged to download the Covid19 Keep Safe app.

HEALTH:

Any person who arrives at the hall with cold or flu symptoms will be requested to leave the premises and seek medical advice. They will not be allowed to return until symptoms have passed.

ATTENDANCE LOG:

Every person entering the dart hall will be asked to provide details as per the attendance sheet (Fig 1). If they do not provide the details requested then they will be asked to leave the premises immediately. These details must be provided each day that they enter the premises. This information is to be recorded by the approved volunteer each day. The information will be kept for the prescribed time as per the government guidelines.

ENTRY AND EXIT:

Entry to the dart hall will be via the front door and this door will only be used as an exit in the event of an emergency.

Members and guests will exit via the side door.

Entry and exit to the toilets is through the door at the rear of the hall.

SANITISERS AND HYGIENE:

Alcohol based hand sanitising liquid is to be made available at the entrance to the hall, on tables and in bar and back door areas. Appropriate signage will be displayed throughout the venue including the entrance and exit doors. It will be compulsory for all persons using our facility to use hand sanitising equipment upon entry to the premises. (This will be monitored by committee members and voluntary staff)
Hand washing signage will be displayed in each restroom and in the kitchen and bar areas.

Sanitising wipes will be made available to members using whiteboard markers and pens. Each time a member finishes using these marker/pens they are to wipe them and place them in the holders provided. Wipes will be disposed of in the rubbish bins provided.

When you practice good hygiene you:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or use sanitiser, including before and after eating, after using the restrooms and after disposing of tissues.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a bent elbow or a tissue.
- Use alcohol-based hand sanitisers and wipes.
- Put used wipes and tissues into the bin.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth and shaking hands.
- Clean and disinfect frequently used surfaces such as benchtops, tables and door handles.
- Clean and disinfect frequently used objects such as pens, eftpos keypad, etc.

SIGNAGE:

Signage will be updated in accordance with changes made by the government authorities.
Signage as per appendices is to be displayed at all times throughout the venue.

SOCIAL DISTANCING:

All members and guests using the facility (this includes the outdoor smoking area) are to maintain a safe distance of 1.5m between them and other members.

No more than 1 person per 4 square meters will be allowed in the hall. If the limitation has been reached then any extra persons will be asked to leave and come back at the next available time.

All food and drinks have to be consumed sitting down, there is to be no standing while drinking or eating, and no drinking to be in the player area

Hall dimensions

Spectator area is 340m , Player Area is 22m
Social distancing = Max 85 persons
